- 12. Contract Amendment John Audet #2021-06-03: The original contract with John Audet for a raingarden project (712M) Section 24, City of Big Lake was approved in June. John requested an additional raingarden project on his property. The new estimated project cost is \$4,056.70. Request approval of 65% cost share, not to exceed \$2,636.84. Funding for this project will be allocated from FY20 Capacity – Structural.
- 13. Fee Structure Uniformity test District Staff would like the Board to consider adding uniformity tests to our fee schedule. Due to staff time, drive time and mileage associated with uniformity testing, the staff is proposing a \$150 fee per pivot (beyond the initial pivot). Historically the District has offered this service for free by incorporating the staff time into various grant opportunities but with the recent increase in interest for Irrigation Water Management due to energy audits and VFD (variable frequency drive) for example the workload has increased. Staff is proposing offering the first pivot for free but operations needing multiple pivots tested will be charged for any additional pivots. Other Districts are charging for this service or considering charging for uniformity tests.
- 14. 16 BELIA AIS-FY21-03, AIS-FY21-04, AISFY21-08: the original grant with Big Eagle Lake Improvement Association for AIS Management Planning, Management and Control was approved on March 11, 2021. The total combined project cost is \$16,785.08 and total grant awarded is \$2,922.50. Funding for this project will be allocated from FY21 AIS.
- 17. Marsha Horton #L2L-2021-05-01: the original contract with Marsha Horton for a Lawns to Legumes demonstration project was approved on June 10, 2021. The total project cost is \$1,425.57, and the project was approved at 90% cost share, not to exceed \$834.50. Funding for this project will be allocated from the FY20 Lawns to Legumes grant.
- Troy Esch #2021-05-05: the original contract with Troy Esch for a Pollinator Planting project was approved on May 13th, 2021. The total project cost is \$567.01, and the project was approved at 75% cost share, not to exceed \$350.00. Funding for this project will be allocated from the FY19 Local Capacity Non-Structural.
- 19. Eric Larson #2021-06-05: the original contract with Eric Larson for a Pollinator Planting project was approved on June 10, 2021. The total project cost is \$814.24, and the project was approved at 75% cost share, not to exceed \$350.00. Funding for this project will be allocated from the FY19 Local Capacity Non-Structural.
- 20. Tom & Heidi Warnke #2021-06-06: the original contract with Heidi Warnke for a Pollinator Planting project was approved on June 10, 2021. The total project cost is \$534.89, and the project was approved at 75% cost share, not to exceed \$318.00. Funding for this project will be allocated from the FY19 Local Capacity – Non-Structural.
- 21. Keith Maruska #NR-FY19-08: the original contract with Keith Maruska for a Nitrate Reduction project was approved on August 13, 2020. The total project cost is \$1,125.00, and the project was approved at a flat rate cost share, not to exceed \$3,000.00. Funding for this project will be allocated from the FY19 CWF Nitrate grant.
- 22. Diamond A Farm #NR-FY19-11: the original contract with Diamond A Farm, LLC for a Nitrate Reduction project was approved on June 10, 2021. The total project cost is \$1,739.48, and the project was approved at a flat rate cost share, not to exceed \$1,620.00. funding for this project will be allocated from the FY19 CWF Nitrate grant.
- 23. Sherburne County Parks Grams Park #2020-08-02: the original contract with Sherburne County Parks for a Native Pollinator Habitat Planting project was approved on August 13, 2020. The total project cost is \$868.75, and the project was approved at 75% cost share, not to exceed \$750.00. Funding for this project will be allocated from the FY19 Local Capacity Non-Structural.
- 24. Tyler Carlson #2021-06-10: the original contract with Tyler Carlson for a Native Pollinator Habitat Planting project was approved on June 10, 2021. The total project cost is \$1,449.56, and the project was approved at 75% cost share, not to exceed \$1,350.00. Funding for this project will be allocated from the FY19 Local Capacity Non-Structural.
- 25. Cash Christian #2021-06-09: the original contract with Cash Christian for a Native Pollinator Habitat Planting was approved on June 10, 2021. The total project cost is \$1,932.75, and the project was approved at a 75% cost share, not to exceed \$1,800.00. funding for this project will be allocated from the FY19 Local Capacity Non-Structural.

- 26. Tim Takach #2021-07-01: The proposed contract with Tim Takach is for a Pollinator Planting project (327) Section 5, Big Lake Township. The estimated project cost is \$861.06. Request approval of 75% cost share, not to exceed \$350.00. Funding for this project will be allocated from FY19 Local Capacity – Non-Structural.
- Shannon Weber #2021-07-02: the proposed contract with Shannon weber is for a Raingarden project (712M) Section 24, City of Big Lake. The estimated project cost is \$2,028.35. Request approval of 65% cost share, not to exceed \$1,318.42. Funding for this project will be allocated from the FY20 Local Capacity Structural.
- 28. 30 Adopt A Drain JPA's As lead agency on the program all JPA's will be submitted to our Board for approval.
- 31. 2020 Audit As part of the audit process the Management Representation letter will need to be submitted to the accountant. Draft audit should be completed this month.
- 32. FY2022 Obwell Contract The District will continue to monitor the 24 obwells in our county. \$30 per reading not to exceed \$1,980.00.
- 33. 2021 OCC Staff unanimously agreed to submit Big Lake Township as the 2021 OCC. In addition to honoring them at the MASWCD Annual Convention we would anticipate highlighting their efforts and present them with a plaque on our Legislative Tour in September.
