Regular Agenda

1. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order by Chair Nelson at 8:30 a.m. A quorum was present.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Nelson led the Board of Supervisors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Open Forum/Introductions

There were no comments from the audience.

4. Approval of Agenda

21.03.01 - Motion by Saxton, second by Goenner to approve the agenda as submitted. Members voting in favor: Saxton, Selvog, Binsfeld, Goenner, Nelson. Motion carried.

5. Secretary's Report - February 11, 2021 Board Meeting Minutes

21.03.02 - Motion by Goenner, second by Saxton to approve the February 11, 2021 Board Meeting Minutes as presented. Members voting in favor: Saxton, Selvog, Binsfeld, Goenner, Nelson. Motion carried.

6. Treasurer's Report - February 2021 Financial Reports

Binsfeld read the February 2021 Program Summary Report. Discussion was had.

- 21.03.03 Motion by Binsfeld, second by Goenner to accept the February 2021 Financial Reports as submitted, subject to audit. Members voting in favor: Saxton, Selvog, Binsfeld, Goenner, Nelson. Motion carried.
- 7. Treasurer's Report March 2021 Accounts Payable The Board reviewed the March 2021 Accounts Payable Summary. The report includes all unpaid bills from 2/11/2021 - 3/10/2021. Check numbers 7134 through 7136 totaling \$1,348.00 were submitted for approval. Discussion was had. Larson noted that one of the checks is a re-print of a lost check sent to a Lake Improvement Association. Discussion was had regarding potential policy of placing a stop payment on lost checks and charging the bank fee to the landowner. Board consensus was to move forward without stop payment at this time, but a policy will be considered in the future.

 Selvog. Motion carried.
- 8. Supervisor Committee Reports & Vouchers Saxton reported attendance at the Rum River 1W1P Policy Committee Meeting, providing a summary of the current discussions. Binsfeld also reported attendance at the Rum River 1W1P Policy Committee Meeting as well as the MCD Meeting, noting that she was appointed Vice Chair. No committee reports from Selvog, Nelson and Goenner.
 - **21.03.05** Motion by Binsfeld, second by Saxton to approve the Supervisor Vouchers as submitted. Members voting in favor: Saxton, Selvog, Binsfeld, Goenner, Nelson. Motion carried.
- 9. District Manager's Report Larson reviewed her written report, noting that the Metro Managers group has been comparing current COVID plans as well as discussing potential long-term options. Discussion was had. Larson also stated that the submitted Pay Equity report was accepted and meets compliance. Further discussion was had.
- 10. NRCS Activity Report— Chris Hogge, NRCS District Conservationist reviewed his written report, providing an update on NRCS programs and technical assistance. Discussion was had.
- **11. District Staff Monthly Reports** Available SWCD staff reviewed their monthly activities with the Board. Individual written reports available upon request.
- 12. Authorization to provide final payment to Farm Friends Barn for a Native Pollinator Habitat project 2020-09-01 for \$1,046.40 Larson reviewed the project with the Board. The original contract with Farm Friends Barn for a restoration of rare or declining habitat project (643) in Section 25, Becker Township was approved on September 10, 2020. The total project cost is \$1,395.20, and the contract was approved at 75% cost share not to exceed \$1,125.00. Funding for this project will be allocated from FY19 Capacity Cost Share.
 - 21.03.06 Motion by Nelson, second by Goenner to provide final payment to Farm Friends
 Barn for a native pollinator habitat project #2020-09-01. Members voting in favor: Nelson,
 Binsfeld, Goenner, Saxton. Selvog abstained. Motion carried.

Authorization to execute FY2021 Agreement for Services with Waterguards for Watercraft Inspection Services Larson reviewed the agreement, noting that there is a small increase in the rate per hour over previous year's rate. The total agreement is for \$24,980.00 (1,249 hours at \$20/ hour). Discussion was had.
