Regular Agenda

1. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order by Chair Goenner at 8:30 a.m. A quorum was present.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Goenner led the Board of Supervisors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Open Forum

There were no comments from the audience.

- 4. Approval of Regular Agenda
 - 22.08.01 Motion by Nelson, second by Binsfeld to approve the agenda as presented. Ali
 members voting in favor. Motion carried.
- 5. Approval of Consent Agenda

Approval of July 14, 2022 Board Meeting Minutes

The July 14, 2022 Board Meeting Minutes were presented.

Authorization to provide final payment to Jean McQuay for a Conservation Cover project, #2021-06-04 for \$931.96 – The original contract with Jean McQuay for a Rain Garden project was approved on June 10, 2021. The total project cost is \$1,433.78, and the project was approved at 65% cost share of eligible expenses not to exceed \$1,318.42. Funding for this project will be allocated from the Cost Share Program funds. Check #7393 was signed at the end of the meeting.

Authorization to provide final payment to Tom Fitzlaff for a Conservation Cover project, #2022-05-03 for \$604.03 — The original contract with Tom Fitzlaff for a Conservation Cover project was approved on May 12, 2022. The total project cost is \$993.65, and the project was approved at 65% cost share not to exceed \$604.03. The actual project cost exceeded the estimate. Funding for this project will be allocated from the Cost Share Program funds. Check #7394 was signed at the end of the meeting.

Authorization to amend cost share contract with R Morrison-Weseloh for a Lawns to Legumes project, L2L-2021-08-01, extend installation date to 12/1/2022 - The original contract with R Morrison-Weseloh for an L2L Pollinator Meadow (725M) and L2L Beneficial Tree & Shrubs planting (723M) in Section 31, Orrock Township installation deadline date was 8/31/2022. Due to unforeseen

weather-related circumstances the project will not be installed prior to the deadline date, requesting extension to 12/31/2022.

• 22.08.02 - Motion by Nelson, second by Goenner to approve the consent agenda with contract #2021-11-01 pulled for discussion. All members voting in favor. Motion carried.

Authorization to provide final payment to Charlie Brown for a Streambank Stabilization project, #2021-11-01, for \$1,669.85 — The original contract with Charlie Brown for a Streambank Stabilization and Conservation Cover project was approved on November 18, 2021. The total project cost is \$2,569.00, and the project was approved at 65% cost share not to exceed \$5,000.00. Larson explained that due to unforeseen circumstances the project will not be completed according to the engineered plans, but payment is requested for the portion of the project that was completed. Larson noted that beaver activity coupled with high spring flooding contributed to the cedar revetment failure along the shoreline. Larson and Gerde are working with an engineer to re-design a hard armor stabilization plan to address the shoreline erosion. Funding for the original project will be allocated from the Cost Share Program funds. Check #7392 was signed at the end of the meeting.

 22.08.03 - Motion by Saxton, second by Binsfeld to approve the final payment to Charlie Brown for a Streambank Stabilization project, #2021-11-01, for \$1,669.85. All members voting in favor. Motion carried.

6. July 2022 Financial Reports

Saxton read the July 2022 Program Summary Report. Discussion was had.

- 7. August 2022 Accounts Payable The Board reviewed the August 2022 Accounts Payable Summary. The report includes all unpaid bills from 7/14/2022 8/10/2022. Check numbers 7379 through 7391 totaling \$26,846.34 were submitted for approval. Discussion was had.
 - **22.08.05** Motion by Saxton, second by Selvog to approve the August 2022 Accounts Payable as submitted. All members voting in favor. Motion carried.
- 8. Supervisor Committee Reports & Vouchers Saxton reported attendance at the Rum River JPE meeting providing a brief summary of items discussed at the meeting. Binsfeld and Selvog reported attendance at the August County Board meeting and Budget Workshop. Selvog reported attendance at the PMLCB meeting (no per diem), MN SWCD Forestry meeting, and the IAM Precision Irrigation Tour. Selvog also updated the Board on the Farm Friends Barn. No committee reports from Nelson, and Goenner.
 - **22.08.06** Motion by Binsfeld, second by Selvog to approve the Supervisor Vouchers as submitted. All members voting in favor. Motion carried.
- 9. District Manager's Report Larson reviewed her monthly activities. Written report available upon request.
- 10. NRCS Activity Report Evans, NRCS District Conservationist reviewed the NRCS activity report, providing an update on NRCS programs and technical assistance. Written report available upon request.
- **11. District Staff Monthly Reports** Available SWCD staff reviewed their monthly activities with the Board. Individual written reports available upon request.
- 12. MRSC 1W1P Update Cibulka provided an update on the Mississippi River St. Cloud One Watershed, One Plan project. Partners within the group have taken the MOA to their respective boards for approval. 8 of 12 boards have approved at this time. Cibulka stated that the staff are planning another Steering Committee meeting soon. Cibulka discussed the CRWD's recent proposal regarding participation in the

- 1W1P project. Discussion was had. Binsfeld and Saxton requested more detailed information on what the CRWD section would include prior to Policy Committee consideration. Further discussion was had.
- 13. Rum River 1W1P Update Cibulka provided a brief update on the Rum River 1W1P JPE, stating that the JPE Board met on July 28th. Officers were elected, the Rum River Comp Plan was adopted through resolution, discussion on JPE Attorney, approval of bylaws, and review of draft annual work plan occurred.
- 14. Review 2021 Draft Audit & Management Discussion and Analysis Larson reviewed the MD&A and discussed the draft audit. Larson noted that the overall net position has increased and the number of months the fund balance will support District Operations is 8.7. Discussion was had. Larson stated that the MD&A will be submitted to the accountant and the required supplementary section in the audit will be updated. The final audit will be sent to the State Auditor's Office for review.

- **15.** Consider 2023-2024 Lease Extension Larson stated that the current lease expires on December 31, 2022. The County Attorney's office has recommended an extension to the current lease as opposed to a new contract. The extension will include the new rates for 2023 and 2024. The Budget Committee reviewed the rate increase and adjusted the county allocation request to reflect the difference. The lease extension will be presented to the County Board on August 16, 2022.
