| EVERGREENS (Coniferous) | | | | | | |
| White Pine Transplants | 80-100' | Fast | Part | Sandy/Loam/Clay | Cover | Excellent timber tree, Preferred Eagle Nesting |
| Norway Pine Transplants | 70-80' | Mod/Fast | Full/Part | Sandy/Well Drained | Cover | Also Known as Red Pine. Minnesota State Tree |
| Black Spruce Transplants | 30-70' | Moderate | Shade | Bog to Dry | Cover | Narrow Crown |
| White Spruce Transplants | 60-80' | Moderate | Full/Part | Variety/Well Drained | Cover | Timber, Windbreaks, Pyramidal shape |
| Balsam Fir Transplants | 40-60' | Slow/Mod | Part | Sand/Silt/Loam | Cover | Flat needles, shade tolerant, pyramidal shape |
| Tamarack Transplants | 50-75' | Fast | Full | Wet or Dry | Cover | Needles turn yellow in fall, then drop |
| LARGE TREES (Deciduous) | | | | | | |
| Crabapple | 20-30' | Moderate | Full | Variety/Well Drained | Cover/Food | Excellent wildlife food and nesting cover |
| Common Chokecherry | 20-25' | Fast | Part | Loamy/Well Drained | Cover/Food | Fruit for jelly & syrup. Erosion control & shelterbelt |
| Hybrid Poplar | 40-60' | Very Fast | Full | Silt/Loam | Nest | Yellow fall color, weed control essential, wildlife benefits |
| River Birch | 40-60' | Mod/Fast | Full/Part | Rich/Wet/Acidic | Nest/Cover | Reddish peeling bark. Found along rivers |
| Rubrum Maple (Red) | 40-60' | Mod/Fast | Full/Part | Variety/Well Drained | Nest/Cover | Early spring flowers, yellow-red fall color. |
| Black Cherry | 60-80' | Mod/Fast | Full | Rich/Well Drained | Nest/Food | Valuable veneer/timber tree. Excellent wildlife food |
| Silver Maple | 40-90' | Fast | Part | Moist | Nest/Food | Drought tolerant, Spreading Crown |
| Hackberry | 30-80' | Mod/Fast | Part | Moist/Well Drained | Nest/Food | Straight Truck, Warty Bark |
| Quaking Aspen | 25-60' | Fast | Full | Sands/Moist | Food | White bark, yellow leaves in fall |
| SMALL TREES & SHRUBS | | | | | | |
| Redosier Dogwood | 12-15' | Fast | Full/Part | Variety/Moist | Food | Red stems, winter color. Excellent for wildlife |
| Wild Plum | 20-25' | Fast | Full | Loam/Sand/Gravel | Cover/Food | Edible red or yellow fruit |
| Serviceberry (Juneberry) | 6-15' | Moderate | Full/Part | Loam/Sandy Loam | Cover/Food | White flowers, edible blue-black fruit |
| American Cranberrybush | 8-12' | Moderate | Full/Part | Loam/Well Drained | Food | Edible fruit-jams, jellies. Holds fruit all winter |
| Sand Cherry | 6-10' | Moderate | Full | Variety/Well Drained | Nest/Food | Edible fruit-jams, jellies. Excellent for wildlife |
| Nannyberry | 8-10' | Moderate | Part | Difficult Sites | Food | Masses of white flowers, Berries |
| Common Lilac (Purple) | 8-10' | Moderate | Full | Variety | Nest/Nectar | Purple Fragrant Flowers |
| American Hazelnut | 4-6' | Moderate | Full | Dry | Nest/Food | Leaves turn orange to red in the fall |
| <p>Terra Sorb comes in a 1 ounce packet to be mixed with 2 1/2 gallons of water. Also called "Blue Slurry". It is used to coat the roots to hold in moisture during planting. One packet will treat between 50 and 100 seedlings, depending on the size of the seedlings.</p> <p>Many of these tree species can be viewed at the Anoka Sand Plain Materials Evaluation and Demonstration Project, located at the University of Minnesota Research Farm on Highway 10 in Becker.
