<p>Terra Sorb comes in a 1 ounce packet to be mixed with 2 1/2 gallons of water. Also called "Blue Slurry". It is used to coat the roots to hold in moisture during planting. One packet will treat between 50 and 100 seedlings, depending on the size of the seedlings.</p> <p>Many of these tree species can be viewed at the Anoka Sand Plain Materials Evaluation and Demonstration Project, located at the University of Minnesota Research Farm on Highway 10 in Becker.
