

State Cost Share Program

Sherburne Soil And Water Conservation District



Sherburne Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) receives cost share funding from the Board of Water and Soil Resources (BWSR) to assist and promote citizens to use Best Management Practices (BMP) to protect and restore the quality of water within Sherburne County.



State Cost-Share Program (SCS)

The State Cost-Share Program was created to provide funds to Soil and Water Conservation Districts (SWCDs) for the implementation of conservation practices that protect and improve water quality by controlling soil erosion and reducing sedimentation.

Through the State-Cost Share Program, landowners can request financial and technical assistance from their local SWCD for the implementation of BWSR approved conservation practices.

When available, cost-share ranges from 40 to 65% of total eligible costs, dependent on project location in relation to surface water.

Conservation Practices Approved for State Cost Share

- Critical Area Stabilization
- Diversions
- Field Windbreaks
- Farmstead Shelterbelts
- Grassed Waterways
- Feedlot Runoff Control
- Riparian Buffer Strips & Filter Strips
- Sediment Retention Erosion or Water Control
- Streambank, Shoreland & Roadside Stabilization
- Strip-cropping (Contour Terraces)
- Wetland Restorations
- Sealing Abandoned Wells
- Raingardens

Applicants should contact Sherburne Soil and Water Conservation District and discuss the potential project. SWCD Staff will contact the applicant on the approval status of the application once a decision has been reached. If the application is approved, a meeting will be scheduled.
