Standard Billing Rate	TBD	Rate determined based upon BWSR Billing Rate Calculation.
Technical Assistance	No Charge	Assist public and private landowners with forest management, tree care, soil health, erosion control, wetlands and water quality and quantity questions. Consultations provide land managers and homeowners with diagnosis of the problem and options for solutions.
Prairie / Pasture Planting with Truax	\$50.00/acre (\$200.00 minimum) plus	May include site preparation for sites enrolled
or Vicon Seeders	\$150.00 Mobilization Fee	in SWCD and BWSR Conservation Programs
Equipment Rental	Ask for Quote	The SWCD offers the following for equipment rental: Weed Wrench, Backpack Sprayer, JD Grain Drill, Detco Tree Planter.
Special Project Planting	Ask for Bid	For cost-shared programs such as CRP, Sherburne County PF, food plots, cover crops, and pollinators. Subject to environmental benefits and landowner reimbursements.
Uniformity Testing	No charge for initial pivot \$150 / Additional Pivots	Assist with set up and take down of the uniformity test (stands and cups), measuring irrigation output, filling out and providing the U of MN Extension Irrigation Uniformity workbook to the landowner and NRCS if applicable.
Water Quality Monitoring	Ask for Bid	SWCD Staff will conduct water resource assessments for private landowners and municipalities that are outside of the normal scope of our work. Contact staff for more information.
Simple Plats/Level 1 Wetland Delineation	\$50/ Hour - \$100.00 Minimum	Desktop review only – no field work.
WCA Wetland Delineations Public Roads and Parks	Per Contract	Provide maps, report and flagged wetland boundaries (not surveyed) for road and park projects in unincorporated areas of the County. These are usually done for the County Public Works, County Parks, and Townships.
WCA Wetland Determinations/ Restoration Orders	No Charge	Includes on-site wetland determinations, wetland types, and needed investigation of WCA violations and other responsibilities outlines in the WCA. Also includes review of delineations and monitoring plans submitted by others.
