LARGE TREES	Aspen, Quaking	25-60'	Fast	Full	White bark, yellow fall color, moist soil, wetland edges
	Birch, Paper	40-70'	Mod/Fast	Full/Part	White peeling bark, excellent fall color, moist soil, wetland edges
	Birch, River	40-60'	Mod/Fast	Full/Part	Reddish peeling bark, found along rivers, tolerates well drained soil
	Cherry, Black	60-80'	Mod/Fast	Full/Part	Excellent wildlife food, well drained soil
	Hackberry	40-60'	Mod/Fast	Full/Part	Excellent wildlife food & nesting cover, variety of soils
	Hickory, Bitternut	60-100'	Moderate	Full/Part	Excellent wildlife food & nesting cover, variety of soils
	Linden, American	50-60'	Moderate	Full/Part	Excellent shade tree, fragrant spring blooms, variety of soils
	Maple, Red	40-60'	Mod/Fast	Full/Part	Early spring flowers, yellow-red fall color, well drained soil
	Maple, Silver	40-90'	Fast	Part	Drought tolerant, spreading crown, tolerates a variety of soils
	Oak, Bi-Color	65-70'	Slow/Mod	Full/Part	State special concerned list, food for wildlife, tolerates a variety of soils
	Oak, Bur	80-100'	Slow	Full/Part	Excellent food source for wildlife, very long living, well drained soil
Poplar, Siouland	70-90'	Fast	Full	Seedless cottonwood, yellow fall color, tolerates a variety of soils	

SMALL TREES & SHRUBS	Cherry, Sand	1-6'	Moderate	Full	Pollinator and wildlife food source, nesting cover, dry prairie
	Chokecherry, Common	10-12'	Fast	Part	Fruit for jelly & syrup, erosion control & shelterbelt, well drained soil
	Crabapple, Red Splendor	20-30'	Moderate	Full	Excellent wildlife food & nesting cover, tolerates a variety of soils
	Cranberrybush	8-12'	Moderate	Full/Part	Edible fruit-jams/jellies, holds fruit all winter, loamy well drained soil
	Dogwood, Gray	3-8'	Mod/Fast	Full/Part	Showy white, well drained soil
	Dogwood, Red-Osier	10-12'	Mod/Fast	Full	Excellent wildlife food & nesting cover, moist soil
	Hazelnut, American	4-6'	Moderate	Full/Part	Leaves turn orange to red in the fall, well drained soil
	Mountain Ash	15-30'	Moderate	Full/Part	Showy white flowers develop into bright orange-red fruit, variety of soils
	Ninebark	2-8'	Moderate	Full/Part	Excellent for pollinators, food and nesting sources for wildlife, sandy soil
	Plum, American	10-15'	Fast	Full	Edible red or yellow fruit, well drained soil
Serviceberry	6-15'	Moderate	Full/Part	White flowers, edible blue-black fruit, tolerates a variety of soils
