

Cost-Share Program

The State Cost-Share Program was created to provide funds to Soil and Water Conservation Districts (SWCDs) for the implementation of conservation practices that protect and improve water quality by controlling soil erosion and reducing sedimentation.


Through the program, landowners can request financial and technical assistance from the Sherburne SWCD for the implementation of approved practices. Cost-share can cover between 40%-65% of eligible costs for projects of \$0 to \$1,000, and 40%-65% to a cap of \$5,000 for projects exceeding \$1,000. Cost-share projects must be maintained by the landowner for 10 years. Well sealing projects will be covered up to 50% of the total cost, not to exceed \$1,000.
